TAX PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Make all payments to: **Town of Trego**. If you would like a receipt please send a self-addressed stamped envelope with your request. We do not send out receipts automatically. **Also please make 2 separate checks if paying both your taxes and dog license at the same time.**

- You may also leave your tax payment at **Citizens Community Federal Bank**, 322 North River St. in Spooner (across from the bowling alley) with a teller. They will be picked up daily.
- **Please note:** We will no longer be accepting credit card payments.

DOG LICENSE INFORMATION/FEEES

- **Non-neutered/non-spayed - \$10.00**
- **Spayed/neutered - \$5.00**
- **Kennel Licenses - \$50.00**
(covers 10 dogs, \$5.00 per dog over 10)



The dog license fees are due on or before January 31st and will expire December 31st each year. If licensed after April 1, 2019 a \$5.00 late fee will be assessed per dog. **Please send a copy of the rabies certificate from the veterinarian for each dog along with a check for your license fees. (the Treasurer must see the certificate each year even if this is a renewal license, according to state statute.)**

If your dog is repeatedly picked up for running at large by the town constable you will be charged a fee and could be cited by State Statute. Again, please make 2 separate checks if paying both your taxes and dog license at the same time.

SNOW REMOVAL – PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS

The Town Board would like to remind everyone that as you remove snow from your driveway this winter, §346.94(5) states that no person may place or cause to be placed upon any highway any substance that is or may be injurious to any vehicle. Pushing snow across the town roads is creating a hazard on some of the town roads; this is a citable offense and will be enforced.

LOTTERY CREDIT INFORMATION

To be eligible for Lottery Credit you must:

1. Live in the Town of Trego as your main residence (at least 6 months and one day per year)
2. Provide "proof of residency" to the Treasurer.
3. Complete and sign a Lottery Credit application which is available from the Town Treasurer.
